2. Best in Academics
3. Excellence in Sports

After scrutiny of the records by the Committee constituted under the Chairmanship of the undersigned, the names of the proposed awardees under the respective categories are as under:

1. Best All-Rounder

After scrutiny of the relevant certificates submitted by the eligible B.Sc./B.Tech students admitted during the Academic Session 2022–23, invited vide the ibid notice dated 03.03.2026, and in accordance with the provisions contained in Academic Regulations 15.12.2 and 15.12.3, the merit list for the Best All-Rounder category has been prepared (**Annexure–I**).

Based on the said merit, it has been proposed to confer the Bank of Baroda Achievers Award for Best All-Rounder, carrying a cash prize of ₹31,000/-, upon:

Terms and Conditions for Best All-Rounder

- i) The student must be enrolled in an Undergraduate Degree Programme and must have been admitted during the Academic Session 2022–23.
- ii) The award has been determined strictly in accordance with Academic Regulations 15.12.2 and 15.12.3 on the basis of the certificates submitted by the students and the following criteria:
 - a) Academics – 70 marks
 - b) Sports – 15 marks
 - c) Extra-curricular Activities – 15 marks
- iii) The student must have passed each course of the relevant programme in the first attempt alongwith other terms and Condition mentioned in the Notice dated 03.03.2026.

2. Best in Academics

It has been proposed to confer the Bank of Baroda Achievers Award for Best in Academics, carrying a cash prize of ₹31,000/-, upon the following undergraduate student admitted during the Academic Session 2022–23:

Ms. Riya Thakur (H-2022-77-BIV)

The award is proposed in recognition of her securing the highest OGPA of **8.88** and for having successfully completed all the prescribed courses from the 1st to the 6th Semester of the Degree Programme without any repetition.

Terms and Conditions for Best in Academics

- i) The student must be enrolled in an Undergraduate Degree Programme and must have been admitted during the Academic Session 2022–23. The student must not have failed, earned a 'US' grade in any course, or repeated any course during the programme.
- ii) The student must have secured the highest OGPA, which shall not be less than 7.50 out of 10.00, upon completion of all prescribed courses up to the 6th Semester of the Degree Programme.

3. Excellence in Sports

For the Excellence in Sports category, the performance of students, irrespective of the degree programme, in the Inter-College Annual Sports Meet 2024–25 has been taken as the basis for evaluation.

Accordingly, it has been proposed to confer the Bank of Baroda Achievers Award for Excellence in Sports, carrying a cash prize of ₹31,000/-, upon the following student:

Ms. Astha Sharma (H-2023-05-D)

The award is proposed in recognition of her outstanding performance and for being declared the Best Sportsperson during the Inter-College Annual Sports Meet 2024–25 held at the Main Campus.

3. Any matter not specifically covered under these guidelines shall be decided by the Committee with the approval of the Competent Authority, whose decision shall be final and binding.

In the event that no valid objections are received by the aforementioned date, it shall be presumed that the awards have been correctly proposed and the decision shall thereafter be treated as final.

The date, time and venue of the Award Ceremony shall be notified separately. The concerned awardees are advised to regularly visit the University website for further updates.
